

Would Have U.S. Prepare Charts For Ocean Ships

Navy and Merchant Vessels Dependent on Foreigners for 1,000 Out of 4,000: Britain Supplies Most

Ship Owners Support Plea by Hydrographic Office for New Appropriations

In an effort to make the United States Navy and merchant marine independent of charts prepared by foreigners, chiefly the British Admiralty, the American Steamship Owners' Association has appealed to Congress to allow the additional appropriation asked by the U.S. Hydrographic Office for this purpose. Resolutions made public yesterday by the association have been forwarded to the Secretary of the Navy, the Director of the Budget and members of the House and Senate committees on Naval Affairs.

It is pointed out by the ship owners that of 4,000 charts now used by the navy and American merchant vessels, more than 1,000 can be obtained only from foreign sources. The statement is made that such indispensable facilities ought rightfully to be available at all times within the United States for our navy and our merchant shipping in the interest of national defense and of our maritime development.

It is estimated that the money spent abroad by the navy and the ship owners, if made available for the Hydrographic Office, would largely offset the cost of preparing these charts, which cover some of the most important water routes. During the war, it was said yesterday, there was a shortage of charts in this country, and many voyages were made under difficulties for lack of up-to-date information.
