WASHINGTON, July 25.—The Army Appropriation bill will be the next measure to be discussed in the Senate, and when it is taken up an important amendment will be made to it.

Under this amendment \$750,000 is appropriated for a gun factory at Watervliet arsenal, West Troy, for the production of torpedoes.

The Senate Finance Committee gave no hearings to-day, and the tariff bill is practically completed so far as the sub-committee is concerned.
