

STREETS DARKENED AGAIN

GRAT LAUGHTER AMONG THE OPERA HEADS

Many were glad that the principal contractors turned on the lighting at 4:30. At 4:30 the street was dark again. Commissioner Gilroy sat at his desk in the Department of Public Works at 8 A. M. yesterday planning for the attack upon the poles and wires.

Lawyer Cravath, representing the Brush and United States companies, heard Mr. Gilroy's orders, and said to Mr. Gilroy: "I will hold you responsible for the destruction of any good wires or poles."

Commissioner Gilroy smiled and said it was all right. Then the workmen were divided into four gangs, as follows:

- Gang No. 1, six men, in charge of Contractor Curran, to start from the central station of the United States Illuminating Company at Twenty-ninth street and First avenue.
- Gang No. 2, six men, in charge of the Superintendent of the Bureau of Engraving and Inspector Fitzpatrick of the Board of Electrical Control.
- Gang No. 3, seven men, in charge of Contractor Hess and Inspector Holt of the Board of Electrical Control.
- Gang No. 4, six men, in charge of Inspector McGuinn of the Bureau of Engraving and Inspector McGuinn of the Board of Electrical Control.

At the suggestion of Commissioner Gibbons the electrical experts were directed to point out "every pole, wire, and fixture which in any way conflicts with any rules of the Board of Electrical Control, and to the rules relating to the height of poles," and to look for:

- 1. All "underwire" wires, 2. All improperly insulated and loose wires, 3. All wires of different sizes, 4. All wires of different colors, 5. All wires of different materials, 6. All wires of different gauges, 7. All wires of different lengths, 8. All wires of different directions, 9. All wires of different heights, 10. All wires of different materials, 11.
