The long-expected Brazilian squadron, the Aquidaban and the Guanabara, arrived at Sandy Hook at 12 o'clock yesterday afternoon.

Capt. Stirling determined to await their arrival, and after signaling the Yorktown, reduced speed to her own.

There was a brisk northwest breeze at the time the water of the bay was broken into choppy waves by the wind.

The Aquidaban rapidly covered the distance between the two points of the bay.

The Guanabara did not reply. It was not her duty to do so, and she was not to be mistaken for the Dolphin.

Then all eyes were turned upon the Aquidaban, and the Dolphin was seen to be the first to present her broadside for saluting.
