

WRECK OF A CABLE ROAD

The first accident on the little cable railroad in Montrose street between Court street and the Wall Street Ferry in Brooklyn occurred at about 9:20 o'clock yesterday morning. Car No. 8, with Brakeman Thomas Halliday and Conductor H. L. Raymond in charge and with six passengers aboard, had a startlingly rapid and perilous descent down the hill between Columbia Heights and the ferry gate.

At Hicks street Brakeman Halliday became confused when he found that Driver Ferdinand Cobb was obstructing the track ahead with the couple of Mr. E. E. Knowlton of 201 Columbia Heights. The brakeman rang his bell and the car started down the hill. Cobb was turned off the track. Hicks street is the official point in the half-mile route of the railroad. It is here that all the cars have to drop the grip, picking it up a few yards further on when the car has crossed the point where the grip is released.

The car bounded down at high speed, but did not leave the tracks. People in front of the ferry house got a powerful start when the car would dash through the ferry gate. There is a two-foot substantial bumper about four feet from the end of the track. The car was dashing against it and was partially wrecked. The wood and iron bumper protruded from the windows were smashed, and the flooring of the front platform was buried through the front of the car. The car jumped up two feet and rested on the bumper and the front of the car. The brakeman and conductor who had been already hurled to the front of the car, were hurled back to the rear.
