THE NEW FIELD GUNS AND CARRIAGES. The Need of Supplying More of Them to the Army and the Militia—The 16-inch Gun. WASHINGTON, July 6.—One of the items in the bill for the Fortifications bill, as drawn by the Ordnance authorities, was for \$25,000 for twenty-five steel guns of 32-inch calibre, such as are used by light batteries in the regular service, and with it an item of \$60,000 to provide the carriages, limbers, and caissons for these guns, and also six combined battery wagons and forges with tools.

In pursuance of a general policy of reduction, the House cut down the appropriation to \$15,000, which will supply fifteen guns, and the carriage appropriation to \$30,000. At least sixty guns are required for the regular army at the present time.

Just What Does "All-Right Necessity" Mean, and Where Shall the Line be Drawn? The Excelsior Board yesterday set the rate for all-right licenses at \$100. Under the new law which went into effect on Monday the minimum fee allowed to be set by the Board was \$30 and the maximum fee was \$150.

The law provides that "an additional license may be granted upon application which shall specify the public occupancy to which such license is desired, and the nature of the business to be conducted during the hours of 1 and 5 o'clock in the morning."
