CONDITION OF THE TREASURY.

The Loss of Gold During January at the Rate of \$500,000 a Day.
WASHINGTON, Jan. 31.—A further loss of \$400,000 in gold is reported at the Treasury today, leaving the gold balance at \$45,500,000. The loss during the month of January was \$1,500,000, or at the rate of \$500,000 a day.

THE SUGAR TRUST CASE BE APPEALED.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 31.—Attorney-General Olney today directed United States District Attorney Ingraham of Philadelphia to appeal the decision of Judge Butler of the United States Circuit Court in the Sugar Trust case, decided last week. The appeal will be taken to the United States Circuit Court of Appeals, and if the cases are then decided adversely to the Government an appeal will be taken to the United States Supreme Court.
