

GEN. H. W. SLOCUM BURIED.

AN IMPRESSIVE MILITARY FUNERAL IN BROOKLYN.

Chattans as Well as Soldiers Honor the Brave General and Good Citizen—Public and Private Mourning.

When Gen. Henry W. Slocum realized that his last hours were numbered, he said he wished that his funeral be private unless his old army companions insisted on a public one. They did not for such a funeral and Gen. Slocum's sons consented. The services were held yesterday afternoon in the Church of the Messiah in Brooklyn, and the dead general's body was buried in military honors.

Clinton avenue, in which was the dead soldier's home, was hung for blocks with crepe and black-edged flags, and along the line of march there were everywhere flags at half mast. From an early hour until 1 o'clock the afternoon hours were filled with the residence to take a last look at the remains of the old soldier.

At the conclusion of these services the casket containing the body was placed in a hearse and taken to the residence of the late general, where it was to be held until the funeral. The casket was draped with the stars and stripes in silk folds, and it rested on a bed of white flowers.

Shortly after 1 o'clock the Rev. Charles H. Hays, pastor of the church, arrived at the house and held private funeral services for the members of the family. Among those present were Mrs. Slocum, Miss Hays, Mr. and Mrs. H. W. Slocum, Miss Rice, Clarence L. Slocum, Capt. Kingsbury, and H. W. Slocum.

The Rev. Mr. Baker read the service for the dead from the pulpit side of the chancel. Then he turned to the altar and read the prayer. The casket was placed on a table in front of the altar.

When the vesting choir had rendered the concluding hymn the eight sermons, accompanied by the choir, were read from the street. As they appeared at the door a military band began to play.
