McElrath revises his figures as to the number of miners out to-day as follows: Alabama, 10,000; Tennessee and Kentucky, 5,000; Virginia, 3,000; Ohio, 26,000; Illinois, 27,000; Pennsylvania, 50,000; Indiana Territory, 2,000; Michigan, 300; Iowa, 1,300. Total, 126,200.

The following is the substance of the news given out at the headquarters to-day: The Maryland miners will hold a state convention to determine whether they will join the strike as a whole or not on Thursday this week.

A meeting of the miners at Charleroi early this morning forced the men at work for the plate glass company to come out. This company has a special contract with the men.
