Gov. Brown Asks for the Repeal of the Law and the Legislature Consents.

PROVIDENCE, Jan. 29.—Gov. D. Russell Brown's first annual message, presented to the General Assembly at its regular winter session, which was opened to-day, gave special attention to the race track law.
