

STRONG AT WORK AGAIN.

MARR PLIMLEY, PLATT MAN, COMMISSIONER OF JURORS.

Tells Him to Be Good and Acknowledge No Honors but the People Swears in the New Excise Commissioners - Bars Out the Mob of Office Seekers Until Now.

As Mayor Strong had been absent from the City Hall since last Thursday, the amount of work which piled up for him to dispose of was enormous, and the crowd of place seekers and others who wanted to get an audience with him was larger yesterday than usual. The Mayor was in a jolly mood when he arrived at the Hall, but when he saw what was before him he gave immediate orders that no one but a few privileged persons be admitted to his presence before noon.

Then he had to attend a meeting of the Sinking Fund at the Comptroller's office, and it was not until after 1 o'clock that the mass of humanity, pushing, perplexing, and swearing in the corridors, felt the line give way and found that the two big policemen who had been holding them back were permitting the first of the mob to file to get to the Mayor's office.

William Plimley, who could easily be picked out as laborer or seekers after minor places not in the gift of the Mayor, but who has been pestering him with his applications, was excluded. The Mayor has tried to see everybody who has called and has found that more of his time has been taken up by applicants for places as street sweepers or jobs on the big pipes than by any one else, and despite his continued assertion that he could do nothing for them, they have continued to bother him until out of sheer desperation they have had to be excluded from the Mayor's office so that public business might be transacted.

The Mayor filled another place yesterday afternoon when he sent for Major William Plimley and swore him in as Commissioner of Jurors to succeed Robert B. Neomey on March 1. Major Plimley will receive a salary of \$5,000 a year until the end of his term, March 1, 1897. He will have the appointment of twenty-five subordinates at salaries ranging down from \$2,500 a year paid to the Deputy Commissioner to \$750 a year paid to the clerks.

Major Plimley is a regular organization Republican who has been in the Mayor's office for a fact that he was appointed so soon after the election of Mayor Morton in the interest of harmony in the local Republican organization may be looked on as suggestive, but it is, in fact, but a coincidence.
