MAY BE POST OFFICE ROBBERS.
United States Prisoners Who Are Believed to Have Broken Lots of Stamps.

John Moore, 30 years old, who refused to give his address, was arraigned before United States Commissioner Shields, in the Federal building yesterday, on a charge of being implicated in the robbery of the Hoboken Post Office on Dec. 2, when postage stamps to the amount of \$5,000 were stolen. Three Post Office inspectors had arrested Moore on Friday last at the corner of Amsterdam avenue and 140th street. Three other men, who were with Moore, were arrested at the same time. They said they were Joseph Kibbons, Charles Allen, and Henry Russell. They were arraigned before Commissioner Shields on Friday and remanded. The Post Office inspectors had been unable to get the necessary evidence against Moore yesterday when he was arraigned, and Commissioner Shields adjourned his case until Monday, when all four prisoners will have a hearing.

The four men are supposed to be the same who on Aug. 2 last opened a vault in the Scranton Post Office and got away with \$8,000 in stamps. They may also be charged with the robbery of the Post Office at Springfield, Ill., which occurred on April 3, when stamps to the value of \$3,000 were stolen.

Post Office Inspector O'Brien of the Boston force left Boston yesterday morning for this city, where he will be charged with the case. He will be met and accompanied by an employee of the New Haven Post Office.
