THAT IS THE CHARACTER OF THE WAR VESSELS NOW BUILDING.

THE NAVY WANTS A TANK.

TO TEST MODELS OF WAR SHIPS BEFORE CONTRACTS ARE MADE.

WASHINGTON, Sept. 13.—Miniature models of war ships are to be made hereafter for the purpose of experimental work.

WASHINGTON, Sept. 13.—The exact location of the Washington Navy Yard, about 400 feet long by 150 feet broad, in which models of all proposed new vessels are to be tested before the Secretary calls for contracts.

One of the greatest obstacles encountered by the Construction Bureau in designing vessels is the determination of a reasonably exact speed which can be obtained with a ship of known displacement.
