THE TOTENVILLE MURDER.

Grimes Has Acted in Self-Defense When He Killed His Brother.

Thomas Grimes, 30 years old, who is locked up in the police station at Totenville, S. I., for stabbing to death his brother, Edward Grimes, in Steven Slover's hotel at Pleasant Plains, S. I., on Saturday morning, will be arraigned before Justice of the Peace Woods in Totenville this afternoon and will be held for the grand jury.

The exact circumstances and cause of the row which led to the murder were not ascertained until the police were notified. The brothers had been living in Slover's hotel for three weeks. Both were engaged in electrical work on the Mount Loretto Mission school building at Pleasant Plains. They were in the employ of John R. Hall of 120 Liberty street.

Thomas told some of his friends some time ago that his brother was married to a woman who had been to the ferry society twice to ask the officers to take care of the girl, but they could not find an anti-mortem statement from the girl's mother, who she would have taken care of the girl for one year.
