### THE DREAM OF UNIVERSAL PEACE.

Rabbi Peetra Mendes Commends It to a Jewish Congregation.  
Rabbi H. Peetra Mendes preached a sermon yesterday morning in the Spanish and Portuguese Synagogue in West Nineteenth street on the advisability of substituting arbitration for war. He referred to the formation of the Peace Society and the action in the British Parliament and in Congress at Washington. He also spoke of the organization of the Bar Association Committee, the meeting of the Catholic Archbishops, the declaration of the Pope in favor of the arbitration of international disputes, and the recent action of the Jewish Congress. Rabbi Mendes said that the Hebrews in all ages had been against war. The prophets in Palestine first proposed arbitration when might was assuredly right. The Jews in Alexandria were the authors of the Sybiline Books, which held up the prospect of the era of peace for mankind. Buddha also foretold a similar era in terms which bear a striking likeness to those and images of the sixteenth chapter of Isaiah.  
"The injustice and the curse of war need not be dated upon," continued the speaker. "War means widows and orphans, the death of brave men, diseased and shortened lives, the evils of consumption, and the legacies of hatred and revenge. All this most agonizing and unending suffering; yet war is but a prize fight on a large scale. You may ask, 'What can we do as individuals?' Every leaf in the forest adds its little to the beauty of the whole and to the autumn of the swaying trees. We must do our share in conversation, and if possible by the vote in favor of arbitration. It would be well if arbitration were made a political issue, and every candidate for Congressional position solemnly pledged to vote always against war and always in favor of arbitration."

### MR. MEIKLEN OF A SUICIDE

The Coroner's Jury Finds that His Death Was Accidental.  
The Coroner's Jury in Brooklyn has found that the death of Valentin Meiklen, the furniture dealer, who was found in his bathroom, at 148 Putnam avenue, on Thursday morning with his throat cut and a razor by his side, was accidental. The evidence showed that Mr. Meiklen had been engaged in shaving himself, and the razor in his hand, he accidentally slashed his throat with the razor. He had no business or other troubles, so far as known, and no cause has been suggested why he should have killed himself.
