QUESTIONS ABOUT SILVER.

The following are answers to various questions about silver which have been received from correspondents during the last week: We should premise that we were wrong in saying last Sunday that the legal ratio of gold to silver was 15.9874 to 1 from 1792 to 1873.

Silver half dollars, quarters, and dimes have been coined extensively by the Government on its own account since 1890, and since 1890 silver was coined according to the ratio of 15.9874 to 1 from 1792 to 1873.

The Government does not give gold coin in exchange for silver dollars. The only nations which now have the free coinage of silver are Mexico, some of the South American republics, and Japan.
