MAYOR'S AERIAL MESSAGE.

Chapter III, Drafts Politically with Public Credits and Correction.

The third installment of the Mayor's annual message was sent to the Board of Aldermen yesterday. It deals with the Departments of Charities and of Correction, and devotes considerable space to the License Bureau.

After declaring that the transfer of the care of the city's institutions to the State makes saving to the city of \$310,000 a year, the message says: "In a city the size of New York the charitable institutions should form a model for the entire country."

"It is not too much to say that a city can be well judged by its advancement materially and socially according to the progress of its poor and unfortunate. It is not necessary that the city's charitable institutions should furnish luxurious accommodations or entail a profligate expenditure of money."

"It is desirable that the hospitals should be able to take care of the city's indigent sick and furnish medical treatment and accommodations consistent with the most advanced science and the greatest progress in municipal affairs."

"One of the main difficulties to be met in the management of the Department of Correction is the length of the term of imprisonment of the prisoners, especially the Tombs and the penitentiary."
