

HARD BATTLES WITH SNOW.

RAILROADS IN THE NORTHWEST BLOCKED BY GREAT DRIFTS.

Powerful Locomotives and Ploughs Disabled While Hacking Against the Frozen Snow—Drifts as High as Houses—Cost of the Struggle Greatly Increased.

MINNEAPOLIS, Jan. 28.—Four different times in the last fifty days the railroads in the central Northwest, covering an area of about 2,000 square miles, have been so blocked with snow as to stop all traffic.

It is very hard to get at the cost of these storms to the railroads, but it is estimated that the cost of leading the trains west through Minnesota and North Dakota, the Northern Pacific and the Great Northern, and the leading road in the northern part of South Dakota, the Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul, have spent not less than \$500,000 in clearing snow from their tracks and in buying additional engines and guards.

On Wednesday of this week five long transcontinental trains on the Northern Pacific road managed to wriggle together out of the snow drifts in which the trains had been held for five days, and passed west across Montana. They bore the first mail from the East since the roads were closed by the snow.
