

Found Trunk Away in Old Store When He Was Removed to a Hospital.

John Kelly, 64 years old, was taken yesterday from a little store on Broadway street and Kingston avenue, Brooklyn, where he had lived nearly half a century, to St. Mary's Hospital, and he will probably die there within a few days. Before his removal he asked the police to make a search through his trunk for some money he had hidden away many years ago. The old man could not recall the exact date, but he said after a long search the police had discovered \$35 in three packages deposited in old trunks which were covered with the accumulated rubbish of fifteen or twenty years. All the members of the old man's family were long deceased, and the money will be placed in the hands of the public administrator.

The trunk was found in a building on Broadway street at the corner of Beavertown avenue, Jersey City, from Dennis O'Halloran, the owner. He said he intended to open a delicatessen store, and that it would be necessary to make alterations. The man put two carpenters at work on Friday morning, and the trunk was found in the place and went away.
