TRAGEDY AT A LAUNCHING.

800 PERSONS THROWN INTO THE THAMES IN LONDON.

The New Battleship Albion Had Just Left the Dock, and the Backwash, as the Flooded into the River, Brought a Staging Filled with Spectators—Thirty Bodies Recovered—Five and Fifty Persons Lost Their Lives.

Special Cable Despatch to The Sun. LONDON, June 21.—The new British battleship Albion was launched from the yards at Blackwall today. The backwash from the launching of the vessel swept against and broke down a staging eight feet long filled with spectators and 300 persons were precipitated into the Thames. Many lives were lost.

The launching was presided over by the Duchess of York. A large and brilliant company of ladies and gentlemen were present, including United States Ambassador Hay and Mrs. Hay. None of the guests was on the stage...

It will be impossible to ascertain the number of persons drowned until the tide reaches the end of its ebb, but thirty bodies had been recovered into this afternoon.

Those who officially took part in the launching were not aware of the disaster until they returned to the carriage window, saw the wreckage was not intended for the use of spectators, and it could not be seen from the bows of the warship, around which the official party was gathered.
