

FINANCIAL AND COMMERCIAL

Until the bank statement came out today the stock market was languid. Its appearance, however, was followed by a rush to sell stocks that carried prices down in violent fashion.

There was hardly a stock on the so-called active list but suffered a material loss in value. There was an absence of support, as there was yesterday. The selling of the market was not to be wondered at. The increasing strength of raw sugar was considered to imply that the sugar trade war was steadily growing more expensive for the concerns engaged in it.

The statement by H. C. Frick that the consolidation of the Carnegie and Frick companies was not to include the Frick property in Pennsylvania was rather puzzling. The notion was still adhered to that there would be, or at least that there was a scheme for a grand combination in some form of leading companies with the Carnegie and Frick companies.

As compared with the final prices of last Saturday the entire list is lower. The more important net declines are in American Sugar Refining, 1 1/2 cent; Reading first preferred, 3/4 cent; American Mining and Smelting, 1/2 cent; and Louisville and Nashville, 3 cent.
