

RICH PLACER DIGGINGS.

RUSH OF PROSPECTORS TO THE NEW FIELD IN LOWER CALIFORNIA.

Miners Taking Out from \$15 to \$20 a Day—Water Very Scarce—Bread and Flour as a Copper-Producing Centre—Activity in the Mines of California and Elsewhere—New from the Rich Cape Nome District.

NEWAYMA, Mexico, May 27.—The new placer diggings in Lower California, now called the San Romé placer, are attracting crowds of prospectors. The estimated value of the placer is \$1,500,000 in gold and has been received here in shipment to San Francisco. The prospectors are taking out an average of from \$15 to \$20 a day each. Another man who went out by way of Calumet says that the placers are all that they have been reported. All the work done by dry washing, which can save only the coarse gold, and water is very scarce. It has to be carried twelve miles to the mines, and at first cost for \$5 per bucket, but is now down to \$2.50 per bucket. The water is being used for irrigation. Mr. Fisher says that some of the ground worked is exceedingly rich and that he has seen nuggets which measured four by six inches. The gold is 1822 fine.

The San Romé placers are 300 miles south from Ensenada and are fifteen miles back from the coast.
