SEVEN NOTED JUST AFTER THE ERUPTION OF PELÉE.

The statements of Death Told by the Attitude of the Boat...

ST. LOUIS, May 27. The Royal Mail steamer Komack, which left Trinidad at a few hours' notice on the evening of May 8...

Provisions were hurriedly packed, as rumor stated that the population was starving at that port...
