

THE CAUSE OF WOMAN.

THE SUFFRAGE MOVEMENT IN NEW SOUTH WALES.

The Upper House Opposed the Bill Giving Women the Right to Vote, the Lower House Aided It—Australian Women Have the Full Franchise Now—Father Scully a Suffragist.

It was said in this column two weeks ago that the report that the Parliament of New South Wales had submitted to a vote of the women whether they wished to be enfranchised doubtless would prove to be a mistake, and such is the case. A letter received from the honorary secretary of the National Council of Women of Australia states that the members of the upper house of the Parliament, who are appointed by the Crown, resisted the woman suffrage bill to the last possible moment, but the Government brought such pressure to bear that they were forced to yield. There was no difficulty in the lower house, which is elected by the voters. It is not stated whether the bill included the right to a seat in the Parliament, but all the women of New South Wales now have the full franchise, on exactly the same terms as men, and can vote for every official and every measure. This is the third of the six Australian States to confer this right.

The letter referred to above states also that in Victoria the Woman Suffrage bill is incorporated in the Reform bill, which has already passed the Assembly, or lower house, and there is hardly a doubt of its passing the Council before the end of the year. This will leave only Queensland and Tasmania, and there will be no special reason for their refusing the State suffrage, as their women, in common with all of those of Australia, have already the franchise for members of both houses of the National Parliament and the right to be elected to those bodies.

The letter further says: "The possession of the Federal and State suffrage necessarily make the work of our National Council of Women much more effective, as now we have the power of the ballot behind us. In former days we had to go into the by-ways and hedges to find a Member of Parliament to address our meetings; but now all that is changed and it is a case of 'embarrassment of riches.' We are hoping great things from Australia, as we have so much on our side—a United Republic to work with, the most democratic form of government in the world, and the absence of that dead mass of conservatism which is such a hindrance to reform work in the older countries."

An account is given also in this letter of the reception which was planned in Melbourne for Miss Vida Goldstein, who will be remembered, came as the delegate from Australia to the International Suffrage Conference at Washington. In December last winter, and afterward lectured in various cities. It was to take place on Aug. 26 and to be presided over by Sir William Lyne, Home Secretary of the Commonwealth.

Can we of the United States by any stretch of the imagination picture a member of our Cabinet presiding over a meeting in honor of a distinguished woman suffragist? Nay, rather we find they one and all flee to the uttermost corners of this great Republic or take ship for a foreign shore, than be caught in such a predicament. But if the women here could vote—ah, then it would be necessary for these dignitaries to draw lots to decide peacefully which should have this great honor—perhaps the should select the one who would be "embarrassment of riches?" Yes, verily, would the women need to be protected from the crowd of admirers who would be competing for the privilege of addressing their meetings. But now they cannot get the smallest Congressman, except from the States where women have the franchise. If the Mayor of a city is compelled to welcome a suffrage convention in the line of his official duties, he holds his hat in his hand, and wishes to get away from the close of his speech and hastens around the corner to the nearest saloon to square himself with his constituents.

The Republican Women's Club of Provo, Utah, has just fitted up elegant rooms, occupying a whole floor of a fine business block. The dedication of this great room marked the opening of the fall campaign for the party. One well-known statesman, who has his eye on the United States Senate, came all night from a distant State to be present and assure the ladies that "his heart was in their work and he would do anything in his power for them. There was midnight liquor and a dance and the guests escorted home by the police at daylight. On the contrary, a sumptuous dinner was served at noon, presided by the Mayor, and a large number of men were present and responses were made to toasts, among them, "The New Woman," "The Ladies' Day," "The Women's Heart," "What Would the World Be Without Men?" "The One Who Rocks the Cradle of the One Who Rules the World." Then at 2 o'clock the public opinion meeting was held in the assembly room, with speeches by men and women, after which the husbands and wives all went harmoniously home to supper, sober and in their right mind.

The State Republican convention of Idaho was in session two days at Boise. On the evening of the first day the Women's Republican Club gave a most interesting program with a musical and literary program, and politics also was discussed in a most interesting way. The next day a convention of the numerous women delegates represented the name of a woman for State Superintendent of Public Instruction, and she was named, "batterly whirly." Everything passed off quietly and decorously.

In Denver last week the Women's Democratic Club opened their new headquarters in large parlors of the Brown Palace Hotel. The rooms were decorated with flowers, dainty refreshments were served on little tables just as at any afternoon reception, and the literary programme differed from the one common at such functions only in the fact that the addresses were of a political nature. The ladies said in the course of her remarks:

of Thomas Jefferson. Even the Republican papers of Denver referred to the beauty and grace of the speakers and the dignity of their addresses. The reader will look in vain for any evidences of deterioration on the part of the women or lack of respect on the part of the men, and there certainly seems to be some improvement in political methods in all of these woman suffrage States.

The Democrats of Colorado have just renominated Mrs. Helen M. Grenfell for her third term as State Superintendent of Public Instruction; also Mrs. Mary C. Bradford as regent of the State University. The Arapahoe County Democratic Convention has elected twenty-two women delegates from Denver to the State and Congressional conventions. The Republicans of this county have elected seventeen women delegates to these conventions and have nominated one woman for Representative in Congress. In the election of the third in the list of eleven in the number of votes received. The Socialists of Arapahoe county have nominated two women for the State Legislature. Miss Permel French has just been renominated by the Democrats of Idaho for a third term as State Superintendent of Public Instruction. Democrats and Republicans consider her the best the State has had. She is a Roman Catholic.

The Rev. Father Thomas Scully, whose funeral services were among the largest ever seen in Cambridge, Mass., was one of the few members of the Catholic clergy who have openly advocated the enfranchisement of women. On one occasion, however, when he was addressing a legislative committee in favor of a suffrage bill, he referred to the fact that the leading members of the Church in England are willing to grant woman full citizenship and said: "Cardinal Archbishop Vaughan of my church has publicly stated that he is for woman suffrage. And if the members of the clergy of our own country, not a few are pronounced in its favor. Educated men and women of the Catholic faith are everywhere ready to be found favorably disposed toward it. I am glad, indeed, that my Church favors the fullest political rights for all, irrespective of sex."

Now, who especially are the women who demand for themselves and their sex this political franchise? Are they those who are ignorant, those who are those whose standards of intelligence, morality and social position are the very highest? They are, for we find every good work for God and country, to help the orphan and widow, to aid the poor, to comfort the distressed, to assist the noble women—wives, mothers, daughters—in all our great and noble undertakings, in their efforts for temperance, public decency and morality. I believe that the Church and State are equally ready to grant them the franchise, and that they are knocking louder and louder, should be granted to them.

These statements are commended to Cardinal Gibbons' perusal.

In the departure of the Rev. Dr. Hober Newton the cause of woman suffrage in the East loses a powerful friend. Not only is he a fearless advocate outside his church, but it is a frequent occurrence for him to refer to the subject in his pulpit, recommending the ballot in the hand of woman as a great help toward solving in many of our social and political problems. In referring to the right of suffrage he almost invariably says, "A right still withheld from woman," or, "speaking of universal suffrage," and in referring to the latter he has been heard to say, "Woman usually humer and thirst in vain for such words from the pulpit, but Sunday after Sunday they hear appeals for the recognition of the rights of every citizen prescribed for existing evils, with never the slightest recognition of the right or the necessity of a woman's having a voice in public affairs."

Dr. Newton will carry a new doctrine as to this question to his charge at Stanford University. Mrs. Stanford has long been a prominent and ardent advocate of suffrage for women, as was her husband, and she contributed largely to the amendment campaign of 1890. California President Jordan always has been able ally, and a majority of the faculty are favorable. The writer of this, who spent several years at that university, can testify to the congenial atmosphere which Dr. Newton will find, not only in this one regard but in spiritual matters also, and yet is not this the very reason why he should have remained in New York? "I come not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance."

By the way; the thanks of the suffrage advocates are due to Mr. Henry Waterston for not including them in his bitter denunciation of the ultra-fashionable and wealthy to consider them a product of the demands made by the suffragists for a larger freedom for women. The two kinds of women are as far apart as the poles. The one is a devotee of society, wit, wit and wit, and she speaks of it at all; while the strongest plea of its advocates is that of the woman in order to give them broader and more serious views of life, and directing their energies toward an infinitely varied and more useful and dignified life, which must eventually be settled through the assistance of women.
