As the brothers appeared, John Gill ran down stairs, but was captured in front of the building and arrested.

G. N. Y. D. SETTLES WITH STEIN

Which Prevents Sheehan, Cantor and Others From Testifying.

Myer J. Stein sued the Greater New York Democracy in the Harlem Municipal Court to recover for his legal services in trying to get the Secretary of State to recognize the organization as a State party. The case was settled before it was reached on the calendar. Two weeks ago Mr. Sheehan had not expected an adjustment, for among those in court as witnesses were John C. Sheehan, Borough President Cantor, Sheriff O'Brien, Deputy Comptroller Phillips, Commissioner of Accounts Russell, and John J. Adams.

Mr. Stein is the executive member of the organization from the Twenty-ninth. His bill amounted to several hundred dollars.

MRS. KEMP GETS \$2,500 A YEAR.

Award of Alimony Pending a Decision in Her Divorce Suit.

Supreme Court Justice O'Gorman has awarded to Mrs. Lella Kemp, who is suing her husband, George Kemp, for a separation, \$2,500 a year alimony for the support of herself and children pending the trial of her suit. The money is to be paid out of an income of \$6,000 a year which the defendant gets from the estate of his father. George Kemp is a brother of Arthur T. Kemp, whose wife, Mary Isabelle Kemp, recently obtained a divorce from him in Newport. Mrs. Arthur T. Kemp is a daughter of Mrs. Frederic Nelson and a sister of Mrs. Reginald Vanderbilt.
