AN EARLY START FOR THE RACES

TO SEE THE MANEUVERS OF THE YACHTS

MURDER ON A STEAMSHIP.

Forensic Flight on the Bristol City—One Killed and Another Badly Hurt.

The steamer Bristol City, twelve days out from Las Palmas, in the Canaries, arrived at Quarantine last night with one of her polygot crew from iron, and the dying of a third, who was buried at sea on Monday night after a three-cornered fight in the forecastle between a Frenchman, a Turk and a Greek, all firemen.

At the turning out of the morning fire-room shift on Monday Jean Lewis, a big Frenchman, and the two boys were alone in the forecastle. Nobody knows how the row started. This is what Capt. Barclay says of it:

"I was awakened about 7 o'clock on Monday morning by some one calling for me at the door of the chart room, in which I was sleeping. I jumped out of my bunk and opened the door, and there I found Zodik covered with blood, supported by two of the crew. I put him in my bunk in the chart room and went aft to the cabin to get some dressings for his wounds."

At the door of the after cabin I met Lewis armed with a club and a knife, and I asked him what he had done, and he mumbled something which I could not understand, and I asked him to give me the club and knife. He gave me the club but wouldn't give me the knife until I promised to protect him from the rest of the crew.

Zodik was stabbed in the left side under the heart. He did not bleed much, but was unconscious. He never regained consciousness and died in about an hour. Andras was stabbed in the left breast and left forearm, and was bleeding profusely. Andras is better to-night, but is in a critical condition."
