### FARO SYSTEM DIDN'T WORK.

Wheeler, Who's 60, Says Phillips, Who's 50, Did Him Out of \$1,000.

Bowen Wheeler, who is 60 years old and says he lives at 60 West 101st street, was the complainant in the Tombs police court yesterday against John Phillips, who is ten years older.

Wheeler's story is that he was introduced to Phillips about three weeks ago and that Phillips offered to put him on to a scheme by which he could beat a faro game. Phillips, according to the story, represented himself as a dealer in a gambling house in West Forty-fifth street, to which he took Wheeler a week ago last Monday.

Phillips dealt the layout and Wheeler played and lost the thousand. When he thought things over he decided that he had been swindled. Phillips was arrested in the Hotel Encicott, Columbus avenue and Eighty-first street. When he was arraigned in court yesterday Assistant District Attorney O'Connor said that he didn't think there were any grounds for a complaint against Phillips because Wheeler had entered into a scheme to beat an unlawful game. Magistrate Barlow dismissed the case.
