Republican Party, Justified by Its Record,

DESERVES CONTINUED RULE

Roosevelt Has Followed in His Predecessors' Steps.

CINCINNATI, June 21.—It was expected that the Hon. Elihu Root in his speech as the temporary chairman of the Republican national convention would sound the keynote of the campaign. His speech was a eulogy of the party's history for nearly fifty years and a plea that it be retained in power.

This is what Mr. Root said: The responsibility of government rests upon the Republican party. The country has been governed by the Republican party since the first inauguration of George Washington.
