Whether because of the unpleasant effect of the announcement in Berlin, or because of a natural profit taking movement after yesterday's favorable crop report, security prices in the early part of the Stock Exchange session to-day were visibly inclined to decline. The market soon rallied, however, and this time under the lead of the granger railroad stocks, which have for many days past been neglected. The market in general became strong, and nearly all active stocks closed at substantial gains.
