

AMONG THE AUTOMOBILISTS.

LONG RACE TO BE ADDED TO FLORIDA MEET.

Sweepstakes of \$100 Open to the World for a 200 Mile Contest—Schedule of Events to Be Soon Issued—Henry Ford on the Value of Racing—Gossip.

The promoters of the annual Florida race meeting on the Ormond-Daytona beach have decided to add to the 200 mile race to the list of events already put out. The event will be open to the world, with an entry fee of \$100 for each machine, all of the money received for entry fees to be used in buying a trophy for the winner.
