PRESSMEN'S STRIKE SPREADS

TYPOSET SAYS CONTRACT HAS BROKEN AND FIGHTS.

Men in Ten Shops in This City Now Out and Some Have Quit in Chicago—Dispute is Over the Open Shop and the Eight Hour Day With Pay for Nine Hours Work.

Men from the pressrooms of three morning printing and publishing concerns joined yesterday the men who left their shops on Friday, but it was said last night at the headquarters of the United Typothetae that the employers had no idea of listening to the demands of the locals of the International Printing Pressmen's Union and that the fight would be carried to a final trial.

John Macintyre, the secretary of the United Typothetae, whose office is at 32 Union Square, said that the strike probably would not last long and that the men who had left the ten shops in this city did not represent the rank and file of the International Printing Pressmen's Union.

Presses are now idle in the following establishments: Livingston, Middlefield & Co., T. L. De Vinne & Co., Winthrop Press, Blanchard Press, Zewa, Wilkinson & Co., Patterson Press, Gillies Press, John C. Wright & Co., the Printing and Publishing Company and the American Book, Note and Company. In all some 320 pressmen and assistants are now out. Committees from localities are waiting on the employees of most of the big houses in the city yesterday, but the result of their calls was not made known last night.

Isaac H. Blanchard, of the executive committee of the Typothetae, said that a committee from the International Printing Pressmen called upon him yesterday and that he told them the members of the Typothetae had no idea of taking water.

"I told them that they had broken their contract and was no reason why we should try to make another one," said he. "I told them further that if existing contracts were to be superseded without even a twenty-four hour notice it was folly to go further. If there is to be a fight it might as well be now as later."

The present difficulty has arisen over differences in regard to elimination of the open shop section of the contract and the insertion of a section which would provide for payment upon a nine hour basis with eight hours work. The International Typothetae rejected its proposals at the convention held at Niagara Falls last month. Mr. Macintyre's explanation of the trouble in this case was an agreement between the International Printing Pressmen's Union and the United Typothetae of America under which until last May there was no trouble at all. Then the I. P. P. A. authorized and directed a renewal of the old agreement with the provision that the United Typothetae make a suitable change regarding an eight hour day with pay for the nine hour day should run into January, after which time the eight hour day would go into effect.


