

SQUABBLE OVER RECEIVERS

Attorney-General and Justice Davies at odds. The Attorney-General and Justice Davies are at odds over the receivership of the Knickerbocker Trust Company.

The Attorney-General made this statement when he was asked if there was any squabbling in the Knickerbocker receivership. He said that the receivers were appointed by Justice Clark in Richmond county.

The Attorney-General said that the receivership was a matter of public interest and that he was not willing to be criticized for it.

The Attorney-General refused to give the name of the man who had attempted to get possession of the paper. He said that the man was a receiver of stolen goods.

There had been intimations from Knickerbocker directors that they might contest the receivership. The Attorney-General said that the Knickerbocker directors had no right to do so.

When the Attorney-General's statement was brought to the attention of Justice Davies, he said that he was not in a position to comment on it.

Mr. Davies said that this statement about an attempt to get a paper from the Knickerbocker was news to him. He had not heard of anybody whom his firm had suggested as having tried to get any paper from the bank.
