LUXURY OF RECEIVERSHIPS

\$673,000 TO DEPOSITORS, \$300,000, SAY, FOR EXPENSES.

In the Way the N. Y. Building Loan Banking Company Trust Seems to Work Out—Daytons to Be Asked Why Their Services Are Worth \$40,000 a Year.

Some of the 12,000 depositors of the New York Building Loan Banking Company, which has been in the hands of Charles M. Preston as receiver since September, 1905, are becoming actively interested in the matter of the huge legal expenses of the receivership.

In contrast with this, these agitated depositors are pointing out, the merely legal cost of the receivership proceedings has already exceeded \$300,000 and will probably fall little short of \$500,000 before the receiver is discharged.

Deputy Attorney-General Frank H. Mott will be on hand this afternoon at the office of Referee Thomas F. Conway, 32 Liberty street, to question the receiver concerning the items of receipts and disbursements shown by Mr. Preston's fourth annual accounting, filed in September last.

Accordingly, Beta Theta Pi, under the leadership of its president, Fred W. Edgewater, has been organized to protest against the receiver's preliminary practice with a spirit of recklessness and daring that indicated that the receiver was not only acting in the interests of the depositors but also in his own.

This is a complete, false, malicious and libelous article, wholly unjustified by the facts, and we have placed the matter in the hands of our attorney with instructions to begin action against you for heavy damages.

The Philippine Plantation Company is a meritorious enterprise that has been handled along straightforward, honest and upright business lines and has a great future before it. There is absolutely nothing in connection with the enterprise that could call forth any criticism in any way.

On a chance that such may be the case THE SUN publishes the following report from the following report from Secretary Forbes to Governor-General Smith:

I have the honor to inform you that I have not yet received from the Philippine Plantation Company that I would not approve their application for a license to transact business in the Philippine Islands on the ground that their company has been guilty of unfair dealing in its relations with the public and in the representations which they have made to induce people to subscribe for stock.
