

DOINGS IN CUBA.

Water for Cienfuegos and Sewers for Havana—Raising the Maine Approved.

HAVANA, March 27.—The Municipal Council of Cienfuegos will vote on the Riley aqueduct contract on Monday. Cienfuegos bitterly opposes the contract, which was one of the matters settled by Gov. Magoon on his recent trip to Havana.

Gov. Magoon has advised the Havana Council that Secretary of War Taft desires the city to be sewered and paved. The municipality, which must provide funds to meet one-third of the cost, must prepare to begin the work.

The proposal now before the American Congress to raise the wreck of the Maine is heartily welcomed by the Americans here and by the Cubans. There is no danger that the United States will find any opposition in raising what remains of the battleship.

The belief is growing that the Zayista faction of the Liberal party and the Conservatives will get second place on the ticket.

ITALIAN MONK'S MURDER.

Christophus, Greek Barber, Arrested on Suspicion of Knowing About It.

George Christophus, a Greek, who runs a barber shop at 49 West Twenty-ninth street, was arrested last night on suspicion of knowing something about the murder last Sunday night of Vincenzo Bonanno, the Italian monk, who was found with his throat cut at 235 East Twenty-ninth street.

Detectives Marxhausen and Murphy of the East Thirty-fifth street station wouldn't say how they happened across the Greek barber in the Italian murder investigation, but they took Mrs. Teresa Barron, who lived across the hall from the dead monk, to the Greek's barber shop to see if she could identify him as the man she saw in Bonanno's room on Sunday night. She said he was, and he was taken to the police station.

Christophus insisted that he couldn't talk Italian, but the detectives notified Lieut. Petrosino, who went up and questioned Christophus in English. Both the barber and his brother-in-law, who went to the station house with him, said he was visiting friends in East Fifteenth street at the time Mrs. Barron said she saw him in Bonanno's room.

When Christophus was searched the detectives found a silk handkerchief bearing the monogram "G. C." A similar handkerchief with the same monogram, the police say, was in the dead monk's hand when he was found.
