

MINES ACTIVE IN IDAHO ALL THE SMELTERS BUSY HANDLING THEIR OUTPUT.

Amalgamated Not Yet at Normal Point in Butte - Two Important Strikes at Bingham - Goldfield Has a New High Grade Ore Record - News of the Big Camps.

HELENA, April 15.—As an evidence of the active mining in Montana, considered separately from the restoration of Butte, reference may be made to the fact that the American Smelting and Refining Company has found it necessary to blow in another furnace at its East Helena plant, thus giving employment to sixty of the men who were laid off during the temporary shutdown. Two of the large blast furnaces are now in operation and Manager Smith states that he thinks it will be necessary to hire two more within the next month. The fact that the Montana Mining Association has concluded a deal for the Panhandle smelter near Sand Point, Idaho, is also evidence of unworked activity. In addition, the Washoe smelter at Anaconda will treat commercial ore in limited quantity. Many large operators have entered into contracts for the treatment of their ore at the Panhandle smelter.

In the Wickes section of Jefferson county great activity is noted. The Wickes-Corbin Copper Mining Company is working two sets of men on its Plonic Gulch property and has struck several rich strings of copper ore. This property is owned by John A.
