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TWO SICILIAN CROOKS PUT AWAY

Only for Counterfeiting, but Suspected of a Characteristic Medley of Crime. The Sicilian counterfeiters and alleged Black Hand leaders, Vincenzo Battaglia and Fortunato Rossi, were found guilty in the United States Circuit Court yesterday...

Battaglia got seven years at Atlanta, Ga., and Rossi two years. In order to disprove the allegation of the defendants that the Government officers had trumped up the charges against them it was necessary for the secret service to make public some of its most carefully guarded methods. A government detective named Casazza called a witness to prove that the accused were dangerous criminals. The detective narrated several episodes in the lives of the defendants and testified that both of them had sold him false money.

When Battaglia was arrested on July 12 some very interesting correspondence from a number of convicts was found on his person. The writers, it appeared, were acquaintances of Battaglia who had been arrested for selling spurious bills. Some of the letters came from New York State prisons and some from New Jersey penitentiaries. Battaglia had posed as a life insurance agent while really a wholesale counterfeiter. He especially affected the 'Jackson' head \$5 bill.

The murder of a rich Sicilian whose life was heavily insured was one of the jobs which assisted United States District Attorney Buckner attempted in New York. In connection with Battaglia's activities, Judge Hand did not agree that this was established. The pretty young American born wife of the murdered man was connected with the trial, and when the conviction of both defendants was announced yesterday morning she burst out weeping and had to be led from the court room.

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MRS. WRIGHT NOT IN COURT.

Absence of Complaint Against Taxi Drivers Worries Her Counsel. When William E. Curson and William H. Young, the two men accused of robbing and attacking Mrs. Wright in Central Park early Wednesday morning, were arraigned before Magistrate O'Connor in the West Side Court yesterday the complainant failed to present herself.

Detective Hagerty stated that he called at 213 East Sixty-sixth street, where Mrs. Wright lives, but did not find her there. Mrs. Wright had not been home for the last day and a half he was told, and that no one there would be of any use in the case was postponed until Monday morning. The \$5,000 bail of the defendants was continued. Patrick J. Kelly, of Nassau street, who said he was Mrs. Wright's attorney, appeared to be concerned because his client did not go to court. He said that she had authorized him to bring suit against the New York National Taxi Company for \$10,000 damages and that she was to have signed the papers in court yesterday morning.
