BESEMER MARKET SAVED.

Good Effects From \$6,000,000-Ton Order From the Steel Corporation.

PITTSBURG, Feb. 13.—The purchase of 50,000 tons of Bessemer iron by the Steel Corporation for equal deliveries over March, April and May, at \$18 a ton, at the close of the week saved the market in Pittsburgh district from tobogganing into demoralization. All grades of pig iron benefited.
