

NEW REPUBLIC JUGGED 'EM

NEW ENGLANDERS TAKEN FOR
BRITISH IN THE AZORES.

Laid in Their Boston Account—Apologized on Behalf of the Republic When Young Whalers Were Unsettled as Real Republicans—Home as Consul's Men

The young New Englanders who were whaling in the schooner Morning Star returned yesterday by the Fabra from Horta, having been put aboard a British ship at Horta, capital of the island of Fayal, in the Azores. They found the pursuit and capture of whales more work than sport. Had luck at the beginning of a cruise that was to be chiefly near the Azores made a bad impression on the amateur sea rovers. They are J. Francis Evans, J. P. Rice, Frank English, William Beales and James H. Ford. They sailed from Boston early in September. Three days out the Morning Star shipped several seas, one of which sent Rice tumbling into what he supposed was the lee scuppers, which he had never been intimate before. He found them very wet and hard and found that it was necessary to hold fast to the lee rail to save himself from going further. A few days later Carlton, his mate, was killed by the pre-

ature explosion of a charge in a bomb. Incidents of this sort rather cooled the spirit of adventure in the quintet, and when the Morning Star put into Horta for supplies they were weary of whaling. The news of the downfall of the Portuguese monarchy reached Horta on October 6, when the young New Englanders had been there more than a week. The island of Fayal immediately endorsed the new republic and displayed flags made for the occasion which evidently had been expected. All the boats of the port abandoned work and with the rest of the population paraded the streets shouting "We are free!" and "Long live the republic!" There are several brass bands in Horta and they turned out and headed processions. The small garrison of soldiers fraternized with the populace and finally were persuaded to join the parade.

The five Yankees enjoyed the tumult, which stopped work on the island for several days, but they were a bit piqued while they were viewing a procession to find themselves surrounded by a lot of angry Azorians, who instead of embracing them as fellow republicans charged them with being English, perhaps because of their Bostonian accent, and rushed them off to jail. The sentiment of the populace was strongly anti-English.

The young men tried to explain that they were Americans and in entire sympathy with anybody who wanted to rebel against any monarchical form of government, but none of their captors understood enough English to appreciate their attitude. They were twenty hours in jail when a keeper who had spent some time in Boston and knew the dialect had a talk with them and discovered who they were. An official apologized to them in the name of the new republic and let them go.

They did not have much money, and the Morning Star had put out for the whaling grounds again after completing her crew of about thirty with Azoreans. The young men then appealed to the American Consul and got passage by the Roma in the steamer.

The Morning Star has won distinction as a whaler on many cruises in several seas. She was originally a bark and was built away back in 1853, when America had a merchant marine and a great whaling fleet.

GIVES AWAY \$60,000.

Louis I. Aaron of Pittsburgh Celebrates His Seventieth Birthday.

PITTSBURGH, Oct. 22.—Louis I. Aaron of 372 Winifred avenue celebrated his seventieth birthday yesterday by distributing about \$60,000 to various charitable institutions in Germany and the United States. Mr. Aaron is president of the Home & Laughlin China Company, Newell, W. Va.; president of the Newell Street Railway Company and president of the North American Manufacturing Company. He is also connected with other corporations.

The exact amount donated was \$59,800, and of this \$26,300 was given to various institutions in Pittsburgh, Philadelphia, Cincinnati and Denver. The bulk of the money donated in this country goes to Pittsburgh charitable institutions. Of the total \$33,500 goes to institutions and persons in his birthplace in Germany. Needy ones who were his associates in his boyhood days have been remembered.

Foreign Safe Cracker Sent Home.

Louis Mandelbaum, an expert safe cracker known throughout Europe under the name of Leibus Brjinski, who was arrested here last summer at the instance of the Belgian Consul and held for extradition, was taken from the Tomba yesterday and put aboard the Red Star liner Finland. Mandelbaum will be taken to Belgium to stand trial on the charge of robbing the vaults of the banking house of Francois and Emil Marck at Liege of \$20,000 marks.
