

BUMPUS' DEPARTURE AFTER MANY ROWS IS TO BE BUSINESS MANAGER OF WISCONSIN UNIVERSITY.

First job of the kind in this country. Natural History Museum's Director Found Fault With President Osborn Committee Dismissed His Charges.

Dr. Bumpus has resigned from the directorship of the American Museum of Natural History and Dr. Bumpus notified the trustees of a special meeting held yesterday.

The questions raised as to the respectability and authority of various officers in the museum seemed to the board important enough to be referred to a special committee which was appointed on November 30, 1910, to give a hearing to the director and consider his criticisms.

The committee, which consisted of Anson W. Hager, August Lakin, J. Ferris R. Pope, Felix M. Warburton, and Seth Low, went into every criticism very thoroughly.

Dr. Bumpus was notified the trustees of a special meeting held yesterday (Thursday) afternoon that he had accepted an appointment as business manager of the University of Wisconsin.

The future direction of the museum will be in the hands of a committee of five men, of whom Dr. Osborn is the head.

Dr. Bumpus has been connected with the Museum of Natural History for ten years. He did not care to make any statement regarding the action of the trustees against his resignation.

CARNEGIE ADDS \$10,000,000 GIFT TO THE INSTITUTION THAT BEARS HIS NAME.

He's Very Proud of the Work It Has Done and Cites Cases—One Good Job Was Saving a Captain From Blame for Losing His Ship—New World's Found.

Andrew Carnegie announced yesterday an additional gift of \$10,000,000 to the Carnegie Institution at Washington, making its total endowment \$25,000,000 and bringing the amount of Mr. Carnegie's philanthropies close to \$200,000,000.

Mr. Carnegie in announcing the gift yesterday said that although the work had been so satisfactory that it had easily justified the gift of an additional \$10,000,000.

Mr. Carnegie said yesterday in continuation of a report of the new gift. "I had a large endowment before, and this \$10,000,000 makes the total of their endowment \$25,000,000, but the institution has already secured successes to justify even that sum.
