\$10,000,000 COMPANY SECURES VAST CONCESSIONS.

Navigation of the Orinoco and Lake Maracaibo Railroad Building Rights in Reserve To Colonize 100 Families a Year—Farm and Industrial Schools.

The contractors are to clean the channels of the lake and the rivers where it is necessary for efficient navigation.

The contractors during the first five years must establish mule and cattle ranches and found agricultural schools and model farms for scientific teaching.

The contractors undertake to establish a company within six months with a capital of at least \$5,000,000 bolivars or \$10,000,000 and give security in the sum of 200,000 bolivars or \$40,000 for the execution of the contract.

The Government guarantees that it will not grant a similar concession during the fifty years duration of this contract.

The contracting company already held the seven following concessions from the Government, which by agreement are now merged in the present big one.

ROME, June 10.—The Pope's only protest in words against the celebration of the jubilee of the Italian unity is contained in a letter to Prince Lancelotti answering letters written by him to the Pope in reference to the celebration, expressing the hope that war against the Church would soon cease.

The Pope thanks the Prince for the sentiments expressed on a day of such sorrow to me and such great mourning to the Holy See. He prays the Lord to shorten the days of tribulation and to convert the enemies of the Church.

The letter is dated June 4, the day the monument to Victor Emmanuel was unveiled.

LONDON, June 10.—The Prince of Wales was invested with the most noble Order of the Garter in the throne room at Windsor Castle to-day. King George, Queen Mary, the Duke of Connaught, Prince Arthur of Connaught and former King Manuel of Portugal and many officers were present to witness the ceremony when the King conferred the accolade upon his eldest son.

Afterward there was a grand pageant of the knights in their robes and with plumed hats over a foot high to St. George's Chapel, where the Bishop of Winchester conducted the service of installation. During the investiture the Bishop pronounced the following quaint admonition:

"To honor God omnipotent and in memory of the blessed martyr St. George tie about thy leg for thy renown this noble garter. Wear it as a symbol of the most illustrious order, never to be forgotten or laid aside, that thereby thou mayest be admonished to be courageous, and having undertaken any just war in which thou shalt be engaged that thou mayest stand firm valiantly, fight successfully and conquer."


