

FIRE TIES UP THE SUBWAY

BLAZING SIGNAL BOX FILLS TUBE WITH SMOKE.

Lands of Passengers Thrown Into Darkness Near Times Square. Firemen and Police Rush to Tunnel on Report That a Train Is Being Consumed.

The motorman of a Bronx Park subway express just after he made the curve at Times Square on his first run after noon yesterday saw vivid bluish flames spouting from the case confining the mechanism of a signal. He did not like the look of it, so he slowed down. The flames growing brighter, he opened the door of his car, hopped to the track and ran down the tube to an emergency switch controlling the power for all four tracks, and threw it down. That meant that trains in that division of the subway went dark and came to a standstill.

The flames in the signal case ceased, but there was still enough fire to send off volumes of pungent smoke. Alley, the motorman, called a guard, who grabbed hand fire extinguishers from a car, and the two got to work at the flames. Alley sent his conductor to the station at Times Square, three blocks below, to report the trouble.

The power house at Ninety-sixth street was already questioning, and the agent at Times Square had not been able to make an intelligent answer.

"Just some trouble, boss," he told A. L. Merritt, superintendent of the subway, "and all the trains are dark."

As soon as Mr. Merritt learned from Alley's conductor where the trouble lay he ordered the current turned on the three tracks which were not directly involved.

He got into an express at Ninety-sixth street and got to Times Square as fast as he could. The trains bound downtown had not had time to pile up yet, and he made the distance to Forty-second street almost on schedule time.

When he got there, though, he found that things weren't what he had expected. A policeman in Broadway seeing smoke coming out of a grating asked some questions.

"A train's a-fire in the subway," a woman told him, "and there is no telling what may happen."

So the policeman sent in a fire alarm. The firemen went down the stairs at Times Square with their axes ready for trouble. Seeing a train moving up town was to use taking chances with a third rail and car wheels, so a battalion chief ordered the power on the local track turned off again.

The prospect of fire engines in Times Square always brings a crowd. Yesterday the crowd swelled to a great size and the rumor went abroad that a train was burning up in the tunnel.

When Mr. Merritt found that his orders to restore power to the three tracks had been interfered with, he started right for headquarters to get the matter cleared up. The battalion chief, whose men were backing at a tie to which the flames had spread, said that it was his business to see that the fire was put out.

"And it's mine to get these trains moving," said Mr. Merritt. He was thinking of the passengers in the dark cars who were wondering what was going to happen next. As a matter of fact, many passengers were a bit nervous in the stalled trains until they knew what the trouble amounted to.

The battalion chief had his way with the uptown locals. So Mr. Merritt ordered that passing traffic near the Times Square station be allowed to walk back along the tracks to daylight. Those between Times Square and the Grand Central were helped aboard downtown express and were taken to the Grand Central.

The time sheets of the Interborough showed that for eight minutes power was off on all four tracks and for forty-five minutes on the uptown express track. The uptown locals were stalled for the same time except that they were stalled between Mr. Merritt's orders and those of the battalion chief.

Even after the firemen had retired it was slow work to get the trains started. Expresses were running languidly from Harlem to Brooklyn. By 1 o'clock, fifteen minutes after the trouble started, it took twenty minutes to go from Ninety-sixth to Seventy-second street, and further down it was worse. Trains which ought to have been going up town didn't move at all.

Mr. Merritt explained afterward that there was no need for so much delay. He supposed it was the duty of the firemen to see that there was an end to all the trouble before they got out, but their presence did the job. It was two hours and a half before the subway got back to normal.

MINISTER IN SEPARATION SUIT.

Letter That Husband Said He Found and Fleed Together.

TRENTON, N. J., Nov. 11.—The name of the Rev. Egidius Kelmeyer, now of Chester, Pa., and formerly of Titusville, N. J., plays a prominent part in the answer filed in the Court of Chancery by William F. Van Arsdale of this city to the suit for maintenance and support begun by his wife, Mary E. Van Arsdale.

Mr. Kelmeyer, who is a Presbyterian minister, left these parts about a year ago. In his answering affidavit Mr. Van Arsdale says that he found a torn letter which when he started to place it together caused his wife to struggle with him. The letter was dated from Pitman Grove, July 29, 1907, and is said to have read as follows:

MY DEAR SWEET GIRL, I would like to arrange a meeting in Philadelphia next week, dear. I will meet you at Broad Street Station, the Reading Terminal, whichever suits best. I would like to be with you. E. KELMEYER.

The husband charged that the wife and the minister had clandestine meetings in Titusville.

STERILIZATION OF DEFECTIVES. Gov. Wilson Names a Commission Under New Law of New Jersey.

TRENTON, N. J., Nov. 11.—Gov. Wilson to-day announced that the members of the commission provided for in the sterilization bill passed at the last session of the Legislature. The bill stipulates that George O. Osborne, head keeper of the New Jersey State prison, Dr. Frank Moore, superintendent of the Halway Reformatory, and Dr. George B. Wight, Commissioner of Charities and Correction, shall be members of the commission which office. The Governor has named Dr. Henry D. Costill of Trenton and Dr. Alexander Macfarlane of Burlington as the two other members. Dr. Costill's term is for three years and Dr. Macfarlane's for five years.

The bill provides for the sterilization of criminally insane persons and defectives at the discretion of the commission. It was presented in the Legislature by Assemblyman White of Burlington county.
