Trustee of Estate Removed

Alleged He Sold Bonds and Invested in Speculation.

Surrogate Coburn yesterday removed Jose Aymer as trustee of the estate of Augustus Aymer, and directed him to turn over \$22,684 to the trustees named in his will.

The application to remove Aymer was made by his nephew, Jose Aymer, who alleged that his uncle had sold \$17,000 of railroad bonds belonging to the estate and had invested the proceeds in the Oppenheimer Institute, which was a speculative and illegal investment.

The Oppenheimer Institute had not paid dividends and is of doubtful value, he said.

The nephew also accused the uncle of failing to invest \$18,000 and of the interest on that amount for thirteen years.
