

ONLY 5 OUT FOR T. R. IN CONGRESS

Fifty-three in House Practically Against Taft, but Wavering.

MOOSE SENATORS

Many Representatives Will Ignore the National Ticket in Fall Election.

PENNA. MEMBERS SCARED

Delegation Prepares for Neutral Course as Between President and Colonel.

Washington, July 30.—A canvass of the Republicans in Congress made by the Sun's correspondent to-day shows a majority of them now intend to quit the republican party and follow Col. Roosevelt into the new Bull Moose organization.

The men who are willing to go thus far with Roosevelt are Senators Moses E. Clapp of Minnesota, Miles Poindexter of Washington, Joseph M. Dixon of Montana and Representatives George Curry of New Mexico and A. W. Lafferty of Oregon.

This does not mean, however, that all the other Republicans in Congress will support President Taft. There are in the House alone fifty-three Republicans who at this time decline to declare themselves for Taft. Nearly all of these are opposed to Mr. Taft, but are in a quandary as to what they are going to do. They have made up their minds to remain within the regular Republican organization and are now figuring how they may maintain their regularity and still refrain from supporting Mr. Taft's candidacy.

Many of them intend to conduct an individual campaign for reelection to Congress regardless of and independent of the Presidential contest. Others, while asserting their regularity, intend to promote Roosevelt's candidacy under the surface.

The Republican members of Congress generally are shy of the Bull Moose movement. Privately most of the progressives acknowledge they are against Taft and hope he will be defeated, but express the firm belief that their own political futures depend upon maintaining at least a pretense of regularity.

A canvass of the Republican progressives in the Senate discloses the following results:

Senator of Idaho disapproves of the third party movement. He supported Roosevelt in the election, but will support Taft for the sake of regularity.

Senator of Oregon is opposed to a third party movement, but wants to support Roosevelt if it will be the party of any possible means may be devised for doing so.

Senator of Nebraska and Nelson of Minnesota will support Taft.

Senator of South Dakota is for Roosevelt, and will try to remain regular, supporting either candidate.

Senator of Iowa is against the third party, and probably will vote for Taft.

Senator of North Dakota is against Taft, but is opposed to a third party movement.

Senator of Minnesota is for Roosevelt and the third party movement. He says there can be no compromise, but will attend the Bull Moose convention.

Senator of Washington agrees with the Bull Moose movement.

Senator of Wisconsin is opposed to both Taft and Roosevelt, but urges regularity and condemns the third party movement. He expects to stump for the regular Republican ticket in Wisconsin and will not be a candidate, but will probably support the Presidential ticket.

Senator of California is opposed to a third party movement, but thinks that Roosevelt is the best supported as a Republican against Taft.

Senator of Montana will head the Bull Moose delegation from Montana to the National convention.

Senator of Kansas is for Roosevelt, but wishes to avoid the third party issue through the fact that the Roosevelt forces in Kansas are in control of the regular organization there.

All of the other Republican Senators, including Henry C. Lodge, Col. Roosevelt's former friend, will actively support Taft and Sherman.
