HENRY ATTACKS T. R. IN DEFENDING WILSON

Taft Regime Also Arraigned in Vitriolic Speech Before House.

COLONEL PERKINS, GARY

Texas Calls It Unholy Alliance—Champ Clark Chuckles at Bryan Praise.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 3.—Representative Robert L. Henry of Texas, one of the Democratic leaders who fought for Gov. Wilson in the Baltimore convention...

Mr. Henry devoted nearly all of the time in which he spoke to a defence of Gov. Wilson, to a vitriolic attack on Theodore Roosevelt and an arraignment of the Taft administration...

Let me analyze the political character of Theodore Roosevelt, the Mad Mullah of American politics, Mr. Henry exclaimed. I charge that he is the friend of the special interests and the predatory classes seeking favors at the hands of the Government...

Roosevelt, enunciated on the bosom of Perkins, Gary and the minions of the Steel Corporation, whispers sweet sympathy in their ears in New York city and is sent forth in the rest of the country to preach a sham crusade in behalf of the people's rights...

They constitute the greatest financial organization and combination in the world's history. He has never forsaken them, and is now making the light for them and under their wing and direction they have not separated and will not should he again win the Presidency as long as Roosevelt serves them with the same fidelity characterizing his conduct...

Mr. Henry made the statement that Roosevelt would have been impeached and Judge Gary and other steel and Harvester men would have been prosecuted in the courts if the facts of Mr. Roosevelt's dealings with them had been known when he was President...

Mr. Henry read from books and speeches of Roosevelt showing the Colonel's attitude toward the farmer and the government by injunction. According to Mr. Henry the Colonel years ago compared cowboys and agricultural laborers and mechanics in this language: "Cowboys are much better fellows and peasanter companions than small farmers or agricultural laborers; nor are the mechanics and workmen of a great city to be mentioned in the same breath with the farmers."

Here is what the Colonel had to say about farmers, according to the Texas member: "I shall confine my remarks to what Gen. Porter has said about patriotism. Patriotism comes first and I hope you will not fail to display it next Tuesday. Mr. Bryan and his adherents have appealed to the basest set in the farmers."

Defending Gov. Wilson Representative Henry declared the Democratic candidate to be a great, grand and good man, who should be victorious and triumphantly inaugurated in March.
