WASHINGTON PREDICTIONS FOR TO-DAY AND TO-MORROW.

For eastern New York and New England, fair to-day; fair to-morrow, with rising temperature; light to moderate westerly winds.

For New Jersey—Fair to-day; fair to-morrow, with rising temperature; light west and northwesterly winds.

NEW YORK, Nov. 2.—The storm which passed eastward over the lake regions was moving off the coast of Nova Scotia yesterday, attended by rain and high winds on the north Atlantic coast.

Rain was falling on the south Atlantic coast, principally over North Carolina. Fair weather prevailed over all the interior of the country and in the middle Atlantic States. There was considerable cold weather over the Western States, covering an area of high pressure, with its centre over Texas. Freezing temperatures prevailed south as far as Atlanta, Ga., and eastward to the Mississippi Valley, where it was from 10 to 14 degrees colder; it was slightly cooler from the Allegheny Mountains to the Atlantic coast.

Killing frosts occurred in Texas, Arkansas, northern Louisiana and northern Mississippi. In this city the day was fair and slightly cooler; winds, fresh northwest; average humidity, 55 per cent; barometer, corrected to read to sea level, at 8 A. M., 29.82; 3 P. M., 29.85.

BANK SUES; OFFICERS ACCUSED. Defendant Says He Signed Note for Use in Business.

Charges against the president and cashier of the First National Bank of Fleetwood, Pa., are made in a suit filed here by the bank against Hiram K. Gaynor, Jr., on a note for \$3,000 which Gaynor executed to the bank. The case is marked for trial this week, but Gaynor submitted an affidavit asking for a stay to permit him to get the testimony of Daniel F. Kelchner, president, and Warren S. Hartman, cashier of the bank. The court granted the stay unless Hartman agrees to come here and testify at the trial.

Gaynor alleged in his affidavit that he made the note while an employee of the Fleetwood Silk Company, of which Kelchner is vice-president and Hartman treasurer. He executed it at the request of Kelchner and Hartman to enable them to borrow from the bank for the silk company in a way that appeared legal. He got no consideration for the note, and understood that he would not be held for the note, he alleges.

Gaynor also swore that other employees of the silk company are required to execute notes in a similar manner. He said that no demand for the payment of the note was made until he left the silk company and brought a suit for commissions.

Myron Sulzberger, counsel for Gaynor, said in an affidavit that he has conferred with the United States District attorney at Philadelphia and with the national bank examiners at Washington concerning what he has learned in connection with the case.

FAVOR MOTOR REORGANIZATION. Progress in New Plan for United States and Columbia Companies. More than 65 per cent. of the indebtedness of the United States Motor Car Company and the Columbia Motor Car Company has been deposited in favor of the reorganization plan. In a circular sent to stockholders of the two companies the reorganization committee says: "If the additional cash to be furnished by the plan of reorganization is added to the aggregate assets as set forth in the statement to the United States District Court enclosed, the amount thereof will be increased to \$15,310,137.80. The liabilities will, through the use of new cash or securities, or both, be reduced to the nominal figure of \$1,300,000. This is disregarding the contingent liabilities on indebtedness of notes of the E. R. Thomas Motor Car Company, referred to in the plan. These contingent liabilities amount to \$400,000. The issue of \$1,500,000 receivers' certificates recently permitted by the court to be authorized in aid of the plan, and the proceeds from the sale of cars that will begin to come in next spring. The receivers expect that a large part of the outstanding contingent liabilities will be completely reconstructed will be covered by current income.
