

FREE WOOL CLOTH NO CHEAPER, BUT BETTER

Clothing Merchants Say Buyer Will Get More Wear for His Money.

ASK TIME FOR ADJUSTMENT Stocks Made Up Six Months in Advance Need Leeway for Marketing.

Dealers in men's clothing are sceptical as to the accuracy of the prediction made by advocates of the new tariff law...

They prefer to say that the price of suits will remain stable but that the quality of the goods will be better.

These merchants are unanimous in their opinion that the date at which the new tariff schedules will become effective ought to be placed sufficiently in the future to safeguard manufacturers...

William H. Browning of Browning, King & Co. said: "In time the placing of raw wool on the free list will surely affect the price of ready-made clothing."

Frank S. Turnbull, vice-president of Rogers, Peet & Co., had this to say: "Free raw wool is going to be a good thing for the manufacturer and the consumer."

The placing of raw wool on the free list will make little difference in the price of high grade suits. It will make a big difference in suits of cheaper grade, where the cost of labor is small.

The stock had belonged to Mrs. Harriet G. Glover, mother of the plaintiff, who lived in South Carolina at the time of the civil war. It was left to her by her brother. In 1868 the stock was converted to a person who had no claim to it...

The bank's answer to the daughter's suit was that the claim is barred by the statute of limitations, but in her reply the plaintiff said that her mother knew nothing about her right to the stock until six years before she brought suit...
