"ANTS" NOT IN CRUSADE

HARTFORD, Conn., Nov. 6.—Condemned to death on March 4, 1914, with her lover, James Plew, for the murder of her husband, William Wakefield of Bristol, Mrs. Bessie Wakefield, who is 24 years old and the mother of two children, took new courage to-day when she learned that leading suffragists of Connecticut had interested themselves in her behalf...

Leaders of the Movement. The women who are leading the movement to get a commutation for the young murderers are Mrs. Thomas N. Hepburn of Hartford, president of the Connecticut Woman's Suffrage Association, and Miss Emily Pearson, State organizer for that body.

Plot to Kill Wakefield. Her husband became suspicious and Mrs. Wakefield and Plew determined to kill him. On June 22 Plew went to the Wakefield home in Bristol at night. Mrs. Wakefield let him in and they went to the room where the murder was committed. Over his face they put a chloroform soaked handkerchief. That didn't work, and Plew tried to strangle the half-conscious man.
