


FRENCH STORM HILL AND ROUT GERMANS

Supreme Court Rules That Gilew and Fellow Russians Were Illegally Excluded.

BOARD HADN'T POWER

WASHINGTON, Oct. 25.—An important opinion that will have the effect of limiting the power of administrative officers to exclude aliens seeking admission at American ports was handed down today by the United States Supreme Court. The decision, which was read by Justice Holmes, will render less elastic in the future the provision of the law which under which thousands of aliens have been denied admission and others excluded on the ground that they were "likely to become a public charge..."
