

ONE SUIT MAY GIVE WOMAN A FORTUNE

Albany Decision Favors Alleged Widow of Edward Tracy, N. Y. Brewer.

CHURCH GIFT RECALLED

The proof upon which Mrs. Hortense Tracy Tracy of Lansingburg, N. Y., relies in bringing suits in New York county to recover a dower interest in property assessed at \$1,000,000 as the widow of Edward Tracy, a brewer, was made known yesterday by Mrs. Tracy's attorneys, Merchant, Olena & Merchant, who also told the history of their client as they knew.

Phippis Property Involved.

One of the largest blocks of realty in which Mrs. Tracy claims a seventh interest in the parcel bounded by seventy-first and Seventy-second streets and Madison and Park avenues, Tracy & Russell bought the plot in 1850 for \$400,000 and it was assessed in 1913 at \$4,000,000. Tracy and his partner divided up the block and the parcels are now held by many persons and corporations. The block is largely occupied by dwellings, and St. James's Protestant Episcopal Church stands on one of the parcels.
