

STEEL PLANTS MAKING ANOTHER NEW RECORD

Greater December Production—May Exceed Output of October and November.

The performance of the steel plants this month will be extraordinary, breaking in all previous December records. In fact there is a probability that even the November and October records of output will be eclipsed.

The traffic situation continues to hamper the iron and steel industries on the Eastern coast. The New York Central is the only Eastern railroad that has no embargo on iron and steel products.

The Interborough Rapid Transit Company has asked for bids on the construction of four different sections of the subway system, calling for about 1,000,000 tons of structural steel.

The Cincinnati, Hamilton and Dayton Railroad has placed contracts for bridges calling for 800 tons of structural steel with the Mount Vernon Bridge Company.

Tenders have been submitted on 500 tons of fabricated structural steel to be used in the building of a department store at Binghamton, N. Y.
